Starting a Blog

Taking surveys

There are sites that can help you make anywhere from pocket change to a full income. These are free to join paid survey sites where you take surveys for a small payback. If you get other members to join under you, then you will get a percentage of their earnings, too. This is how you make real money. Some people have reported verifiable earnings of around \$1,800 per month this way.

Downloading and installing apps

A lot of companies, including Google, pay you for installing their apps. Moreover, you get paid for each month the apps are installed on your phone. Some of these sites include: ShopTracker and MobileXpression



Review stuff

You can turn this into an opportunity to earn an income, and one way to do it would be by writing reviews for various products and getting paid for it. Posting and writing a review can earn you anywhere between \$5 and \$50 per review, based on the requirements. Yelp and ReviewMe can give you some special invites.

Testing websites

These involve visiting a specific Web site and performing an exact function on the website. While you are performing the task, your screen is being recorded to track your mouse movement and clicks. Also, your voice is recorded as you verbalize your steps on the website. You can earn about \$10 for about 10 to 20 minutes of website testing.

Signing up for gift cards

This involves Earning Free Cash & Gift Cards for things you do online every day. Ebates gives you a \$10 gift card when you sign up and earn your first cashback refund. It's great for online shoppers. You can redeem your points for gift cards to your favorite stores, such as Amazon.com and Walmart, or redeem your points for cash through PayPal. It's easy and fun!

Get paid for being healthy

Being healthy already has so many benefits, but you can also get paid for being healthy. The health app AchieveMint gives you points for being healthy and doing things like walking, tracking your food, or taking health surveys. You can earn points which can be redeemed for cash or Amazon Gift Cards. For every 10,000 points, you earn \$10, and there is no limit on your earnings.



Become a freelancer

Freelancing is a time honored way for writers and graphic designers to make money. It's not uncommon for administrative assistants, accountants, computer programmers and other professionals to also find freelance opportunities. Look at niche job sites such as Upwork, Guru, and Fiverr.

If you're a super speedy typist, have a good ear and write well, you might be cut out for transcription work. Transcribers provide closed captioning for films and TV shows, and written transcripts of academic presentations and focus groups.

Virtual assistant

A virtual assistant is self-employed and provides professional administrative or technical assistance to clients remotely from a home office. Becoming a Virtual Assistant can be a life changing experience if you have strong administrative skills, are organized, capable of working with deadlines and would like to run a business from home.

Virtual assistances (VAs) can do everything from checking emails and making travel plans to handling internet research or working for their small business. High-end earners can command \$30-\$100 an hour. Some reputable sites for virtual assistants are Zirtual and Upwork

Tutoring

Tutoring Services is a centralized academic online support service consisting of peer facilitated learning experiences for undergraduates interested in requesting or becoming a tutor for students. Choose your schedule if you have some imperative routine tasks, or go for online tutoring and earn \$20 per hour on Chegg Tutors.



Rate pizzas

Pizza is a yeasted flatbread topped with tomato sauce, cheese and other items, all baked in an oven. Many companies pay you for rating local pizza shops. You just have to get a login for Trendsource to rate the place on the quality of their pizza and note their delivery time. For this, you can get \$5 for rating a pizza.

Work for Amazon

Have you heard of Amazon Mechanical Turk? Unlike other online sites that look for contract help, the Amazon Mechanical Turk service offers easy to accomplish tasks that can be completed by almost anyone with a computer. These are services that require human interaction. You can work from home, have flexible hours and get paid by one of the world's largest retailers.

Selling lesson plans

This involves the online selling of your lesson plans especially to new teachers. Teachers-Pay-Teachers is a marketplace for educators where you can sell and share your teaching resources.

Maintaining social media accounts

There are more money making opportunities on social media than you might realize. Maintaining social media accounts like Facebook, Twitter, and LinkedIn, in fact, can be quite lucrative and high paying.

Maintaining fan pages

Facebook pages are the biggest source of earning money online. You can rapidly earn with Facebook Fan Pages, Likes & Groups. You can also sell products there

Google Checkout is Google's answer to PayPal. Google Checkout allows users to pay for goods and services through an account connected to their Google profile.

The major benefit that Google Checkout has over the competition is that millions of Internet users use Google for other services, making a purchase through Checkout as a simpler process.

WePay is a payment processor that allows Internet merchants to accept credit cards and bank account payments online.

WePay seems to be focused on the individual user, and has recently added estore pages to their service to help their customers conveniently take payments through their service.

Advertising is all about getting your business in front of a potential customer who is interested in your product or service. Today, more small organizations are





coming online to increase sales, gain support, and reach a rapidly growing market.

There are some different ways in which a website can get itself advertised on the web. Some companies will send you sample products, while others will send full sized ones, which you will test every month and then pay you for giving them your thoughts on the products. These online testing companies include:






Enrollapp.com




Testing Time is open to global residents that hire and pay individuals to test digital products via Skype. You can earn up to €50 per study. Each study is





The reason this is such a great opportunity for moms is that the tasks can be completed at any time, and the majority of short tasks don't require moms to be on the phone, which requires a quiet household.




How to Get Started as a Freelancer

- ✓ Once you have your gigs up and running and are making some decent money, you can start outsourcing your work for pennies on the dollar. For instance, set up an eBook cover design gig and have your hired help do all the work. Even after you pay your employee, you should still make a profit. This is a great way to focus on other money-making activities, such as creating new gigs.
- ✓ Find a successful gig, and offer similar services, but include a free bonus.

 Giving the client a guide to teach them the skills that you are providing will give the customer more bang for their buck.

Freelancer.com



Freelancer is a marketplace where employers and employees can find each other. The site allows employers to post work to be done.

Anyone is able to offer quotes to complete the project, upon which the employer can award the work.

At Freelancer, you can make money from freelancing services, content writing, translating, graphic designing, programming and other categories, as well.

Freelancer takes a 10% fee, which can be reduced with a paid monthly membership, with a minimum fee of \$5.

How to Make Money from Freelancer.com

The moment you sign up, you'll have an account at Freelancer. You are free to start making money online by browsing projects by category or by title. You can search the projects you are interested in, and the ones that match your experience and fields of interest.

Then, considering the employer's requirements, you place your bid on different projects, depending on the minimum and maximum amount of money offered by the employer.




Making money from Freelancer can be easier when you upgrade your membership. Beyond the free membership, there is the basic one, which enables you to place 50 bids per month and select up to 30 categories of skills.

Then, there is the standard membership, offering you 150 bids monthly, with an option of 60 skills selection. The higher you upgrade your membership, the more chance you have to make money online from Freelancer.

The premium membership allows you 500 bids every month and enables you to choose 100 different types of skills for your profile, which also means that your chances of being awarded projects are increased.

Guru.com



Guru operates as a platform to match up outsourced service providers with people in need of their services. Guru has over 100 categories that you can choose from when submitting outsourced tasks and campaigns.

Here's how it works

As an employer, you submit your job description and specs. Outsourcers in the category you specified read your project description and can bid on the task.



You receive their bids, and can then respond through Guru's messaging system or take the conversation to your personal email or call.

Once you have reached an agreement with a provider, you can have them submit an invoice or escrow for the service, along with delivery dates that coincide with payment being released. Payment is secured using SafePay.

The big upside of Guru is that you can receive bids from different sources. Freelance individuals, as well as companies, will respond to your projects, and you can get a good idea of the going rate for the service you need.

There are two kinds of Guru freelancers. Free members don't pay a fee and can only bid on a few projects, these are usually individuals with the most risk, but will likely have the lowest rates to complete your project.

There are also paid members who pay a small annual fee and can bid on a large number of projects. These are typically companies or very successful individuals that focus on a particular task and will have higher rates, but also have the feedback and references to back them up.

PeoplePerHour is a UK based website that enables users to earn money online by advertising freelance opportunities for both Buyers and Sellers.

Building up a profile

Building up a profile means to build your profile to such an extent that the Buyers can find you easily and offer you a job.

With your free membership, you can bid on up to 15 jobs per month.

Although it's not impossible to get started this way, most new freelancers will find they need to bid on more than 15 jobs each week.





Evernote





SurveyMonkey's software is incredibly simple. In just minutes, you can design, create and publish your business survey. Additionally, you'll be able to analyze the results in the backend.




Chapter 15: Shocking Case Studies

The Internet offers some great money making opportunities for Individuals with computer knowledge and the skills required to thrive in this online medium.

Utilizing the internet and having a strong online presence makes connecting with fans and earnings much more achievable. Below are some great case studies of marketers who found success through an online campaign.

Affiliate Marketing Case Study



Many people like to think of creating an online income and financial freedom with affiliate marketing. While this is certainly possible, you must start small and build your business from the ground up. This is an affiliate case study of how you can make \$500 per month.

Step 1: Write ten articles about a niche Clickbank product that are keyword rich with effective titles. The title will ensure that your article gets a lot of clicks.

Step 2: Find five other Clickbank products that have nothing to do with making money online and promote them with eBay classified ads. An eBay classified ad only costs \$9.95 and runs for 30 days. This is a tremendous value because each ad will probably make you \$60-\$80 in profit.

If you put these two systems together and send your customers to your affiliate link with the articles and the eBay classified ads, then you should see \$500 a month, which is proven by this affiliate case study.

My friend Clark used this exact method, and the results were as follows:

-Five sales from the product he promoted with articles totaled \$133.60, and all of that was straight profit requiring no investment but time.

-Of the five different products he promoted with eBay classified ads, he made a total of 13 sales averaging \$35.14 per sale totalling \$456.82.

Add these numbers together, and you have an affiliate marketing case study that made \$590.42 in gross sales.

The five eBay classified ads cost a total of \$49.75. As you can see, he made about \$10 for every dollar that he spent with eBay classifieds, which is a phenomenal ROI.



Fiverr Case Study



Getting started on Fiverr is quick and easy, which made it convenient. This setup appeals to side hustlers who don't want to spend a lot of time getting started on a platform to make some money.

Getting featured on the Homepage involves some criteria including:

- A unique offer with a broad appeal. On the homepage, Fiverr needs to showcase the breadth of services people can find on the site.
- Something that people might be surprised to get for \$5.
- A proven high-converting offer. Fiverr tracks a rolling 30-day conversion rate for each gig — meaning the percentage of people who view your offer and end up buying it.
- A higher than average order value.
- Excellent feedback. The final criteria that make my top 5 factors to get on the Fiverr homepage is a history of excellent feedback. You probably need to shoot as close to 100% positive reviews as you can. On top of that, you



must have a high percentage of customers leaving positive feedback vs. none at all.

In total, the exposure generated 80 orders in 10 days, for a total of \$1,150 in revenue. After Fiverr's cut, I cleared \$920.

The average order value was \$14.37.

The majority of the revenue came from a minority of the customers; 25% of the customers generated 70% of the income. Not quite 80/20, but close!

Email Marketing Case Study



When you combine email marketing with a good idea and solid data, the results can be tremendous, and those results might only be the beginning.

Case-Mate tested a flash sale in early December and increased revenue by 236%. Then, the team relaunched two weeks later and more than doubled the first sale's conversion rate.

The first flash sale was a big success. The changes the team made for the second sale pushed its conversion rate even higher.



"We saw revenue, traffic and all the conversion metrics we measure go up, which was exciting to see," the company said. "The numbers, as far as conversion rate, were pretty consistent between the two. The second one was slightly higher, but the first one still performed well."


Here's how the first sale performed compared to Case-Mate's average metrics:

- 51% increase in traffic
- 50% increase in conversion rate (purchases divided by visits to the landing page)
- 236% increase in revenue

Here's how the second sale performed against the previous team's averages:

- 5% increase in traffic
- 105% increase in conversion rate (purchases divided by visits to the landing page)
- 78% increase in revenue

Selling some stuff Case Study





Affiliate Marketing is an online marketing method where website owners promote third party products on their websites or blogs.

The Bluehost web hosting affiliate program offers one of the highest affiliate commissions. It offers \$65 per sale as commission to its affiliates, through your affiliate account.

If you make ten sales through your affiliate account in a month, the amount that is payable to you would be \$650. Below is the case study Harsh sells with Bluehost.

An affiliate partnership with Harsh from ShoutMeLoud is one of the things that helped him make over \$16,000 by promoting one product - Bluehost.

Things You Need To Make a Successful Affiliate Partnership

- Be Honest
- Connect Personally
- Let Your Work Do The Talking

Social Media Case Study





Amanda Palmer is widely known for her social media expertise. Advertising Age said, "Palmer is more sophisticated than almost anyone on the internet — musician, brand or otherwise — when it comes to gathering her audience around her and keeping the conversation going."

On a boring Friday night, Amanda managed to rake in \$11,000 in just two hours. It all started with her tweeting about how she was alone, again, on a Friday night sitting in front of her computer. Others started chiming in and began claiming how "we are all losers."

The dialogue continued and grew at a rapid pace. A faux organization was started called, "The Losers of Friday Night on their Computers." Amanda created the hashtag #LOFNOTC and thousands joined the conversation.

A follower suggested the group create a t-shirt. Amanda quickly decided to run with it. She took a sharpie and made a t-shirt design. A website was thrown up that night with the t-shirts available for \$25 apiece. 2 hours later, she had \$11,000.

What can you learn from this example?

- Interact with your followers and don't just mass broadcast.
- Be personable and share a variety of things with your fans.
- Always be on your toes, ready to act quickly when the opportunity arises.
