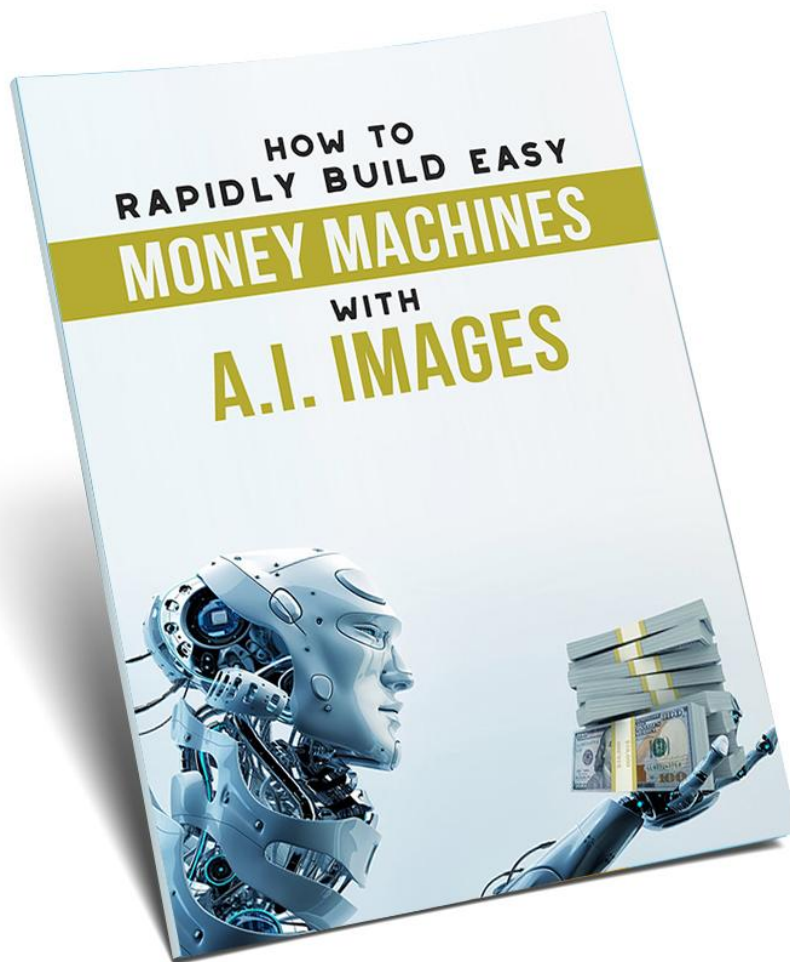



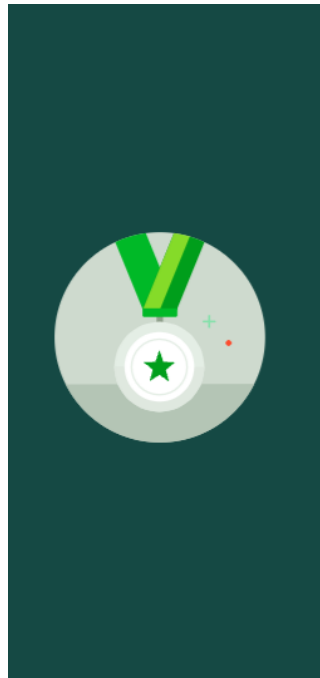

Upon entering 'AI generated images' as keywords, Upwork showed me a long list of available jobs I could apply for. Of course, there are more chances if you try other keywords like 'AI image generation,' 'AI images,' etc.

What's great is that you can also filter those jobs according to your experience level, the job type you're looking for, offered rates, and job posters with a history of accommodating more proposals or working with other freelancers on the platform.

You can just click any job posting that catches your eye, and it'll show you this:

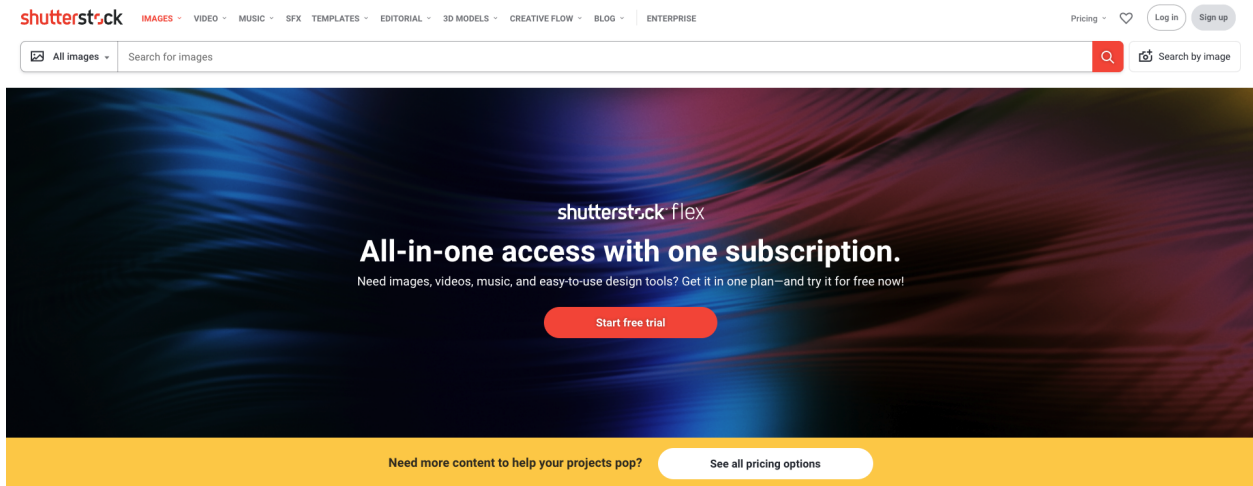

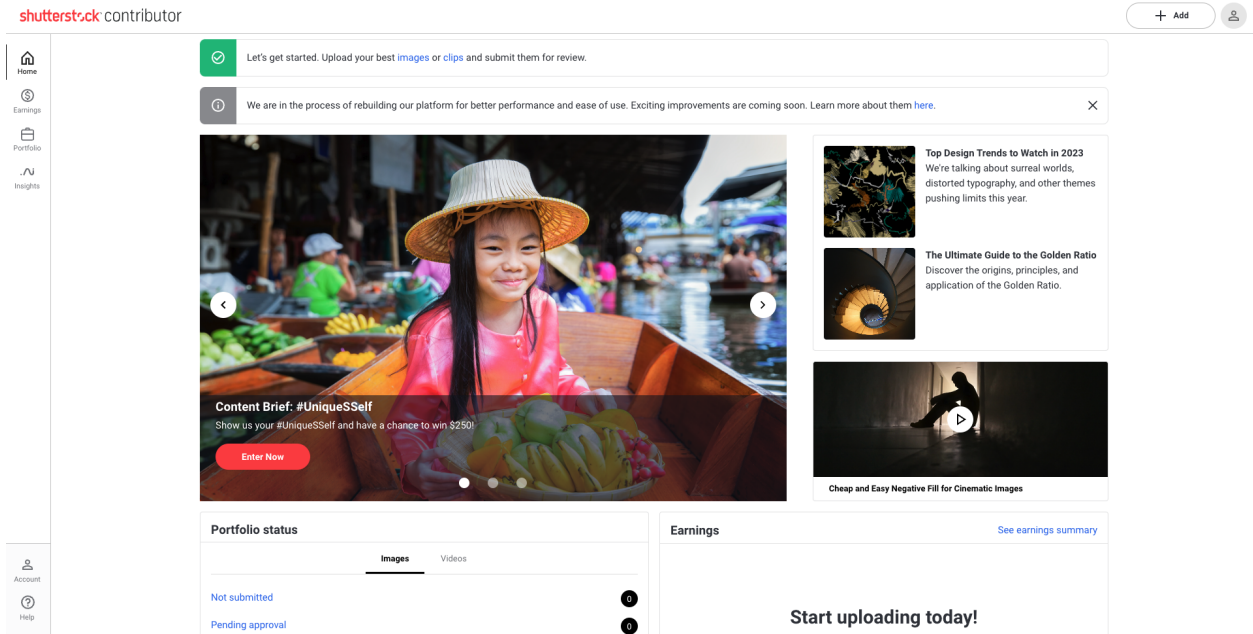
